


# Canada's Six New Immigration Streams



- Canada is committed to achieving its target of 401,000 new PRs in 2021
- Essential workers and graduates are vital to Canada's post-pandemic economic recovery
- Six new PR streams launching May 6



# Canada's Six New Immigration Streams




#### What are the streams?

- PR pathway for health care workers (20,000 applications);
- PR pathway for workers in other essential occupations (30,000 applications);
- PR pathway for international graduates (40,000 applications).
- Note: Open until Nov. 5 or when quotas are reached.



# Canada's Six New Immigration Streams



#### What are the French-speaking streams?

- PR pathway for French-speaking health care workers;
- PR pathway for French-speaking workers in other essential occupations;
- PR pathway for French-speaking international graduates.
- Note: Also open until Nov. 5. No quotas.

## PR Pathway for Healthcare Workers

- Must have work experience in an eligible occupation (<u>Annex A</u>);
- Must be employed at the time of application (with authorization);
- Must have a language proficiency of at least CLB/NCLC 4 in English or French;
- Must live in Canada and be physically present when the application is received and when the application is approved;
- Must intend to live outside Quebec;
- Must submit application online;
- Must be admissible.



## PR Pathway for French-speaking Healthcare Workers

- Same requirements as previous program, except for language proficiency;
- Candidate must be proficient in the French language with an NCLC of 4.



## PR Pathway for Workers in Other Essential Occupations

- Must have work experience in an eligible occupation (<u>Annex B</u>, or a combination of Annex A and Annex B);
- Must be employed at the time of application (with authorization);
- Must have a language proficiency of at least CLB/NCLC 4 in English or French;
- Must live in Canada and be physically present at the time the application is received and is approved;
- Must intend to live outside Quebec;
- Must submit application online;
- Must be admissible.



## PR Pathway for French-speaking Workers in Other Essential Occupations

- Same requirements as previous program, except for language proficiency;
- Candidate must be proficient in the French language with an NCLC of 4.



### **PR Pathway for International Graduates**

- Must have graduated from a designated learning institution no earlier than January 2017;
- Must have been granted an eligible credential after completing their education;
- Must have been authorized to study throughout their education;
- Must be employed in Canada (with authorization);
- Must have a language proficiency of at least CLB/NCLC 5 in English or French;
- Must live in Canada and be physically present at the time the application is received and is approved;
- Must intend to live outside Quebec;
- Must submit the application online;
- Must be admissible.




## PR Pathway for French-speaking International Graduates

- Same requirements as previous program, except for language proficiency;
- Candidate must be proficient in the French language with an NCLC of 5.
